On May 14, 2009, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, RCRA Programs Section issued a Notice of Violation and a Compliance Order/Settlement Agreement concerning underground storage tank (UST) violation (i.e., spill prevention), found at the Federal Bureau of Prison facility, Highway 40 and 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Post Office Box 4000, Greenville, Illinois. This letter is to inform you that we have received your signed copy of the Settlement Agreement, dated June 26, 2009, and your supporting documentation stating that the UST violation was addressed. In addition, we received your check/ intragovernment transfers of credit for a total of \$300.00 in penalties.
