EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

for violating the following requirements of Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act: 40 CFR § 68.67; 40 CFR § 68.69; and 40 CFR § 68.79.

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 4, the Director of the Air, Pesticides and Toxics Management Division (Complainant), and by the Chattanooga Waste Resources Division (Respondent), pursuant to Section 113(a)(3) and (d) of the Clean Air Act (the "Act"), 42 U.S.C. § 7413(a)(3) and (d), and by 40 CFR § 22.13(b).

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

Based on a compliance monitoring inspection conducted at the Moccasin Bend Wastewater Treatment Plant on September 7, 2005, EPA alleges that the Respondent violated the Act's Chemical Accident Prevention Program when:

Respondent did not provide evidence that it has retained all process hazard analyses for the life of the covered process as required by 40 CFR § 68.67(g);

Respondent did not provide evidence that it has developed and implemented written operating procedures that address the following elements found at 40 CFR § 68.69(a): Operating limits, including (2)(i) consequences of deviation and (2)(ii) steps required to correct or avoid deviation, Safety and health considerations, including (3)(i) properties of, and hazards presented by, the chemicals used in the process, and (3)(iii) control measures to be taken if physical contact or airborne exposure occurs;

Respondent did not provide evidence that it has annually certified the operating procedures (i.e., that the procedures are current and accurate) on an annual basis as required by 40 CFR § 68.69(c); and

Respondent did not provide evidence that at least every three years, Respondent has evaluated its compliance with the prevention program requirements and certified that its procedures and practices are adequate and are being followed as required by 40 CFR § 68.79(a).

SETTLEMENT

In consideration of Respondent's size, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violations cited above, for the total penalty amount of \$3600.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions: the Respondent by signing below admits the jurisdictional allegations contained herein, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above; Respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C § 7413(d)(2)(A), and to contest the allegations contained in this ESA; and each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.

Respondent certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that the Respondent has corrected the alleged violation listed in this ESA. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$3600. Please note that payment should not be made until after Respondent receives a copy of the fully executed ESA. Within fifteen (15) days after receiving a copy of the fully executed ESA, the Respondent shall send a cashier's check or certified check (payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America") in the amount of \$3600, in payment of the full penalty amount to the following address:
