MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF  
TIME IN WHICH TO ANSWER THE  
ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

Proceedings Under Section 309(g)(2)(B)  
Of the Clean Water Act and Section  
3008(a) of the Resource Conservation and  
Recovery Act

I. NEED FOR AN EXTENSION

On Thursday, August 14, 2009, Town of Plaistow received the Administrative Complaint and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in the above-captioned matter. After contacting and discussing this request with the EPA case attorney, Kathleen Woodward, and after scheduling several meetings on Tuesday, September 22, Thursday, October 8, and Thursday, October 22, to discuss the details of a propose settlement with EPA representatives, the Town of Plaistow is now requesting a forty-five day (45) day extension of the deadline for filing an answer to the administrative complaint. At this point, the Town has reached a settlement in principle and we need the extension to work out the details and finalize the settlement document.

This extension is necessary in order to further define the possibility for settlement of this matter so that the Town of Plaistow can avoid incurring unnecessary litigation costs which would further challenge the financial stability of the business. We have scheduled another informal settlement conference with EPA Region I on October 29<sup>th</sup> as we continue to explore an agreeable settlement. It would impose an unnecessary and wasteful financial burden on the Town of Plaistow to require preparation of an answer to the Administrative Complaint if, as appears possible, settlement of this matter and full compliance with the relevant regulations can be achieved without having to do so. The requested forty-five day extension should provide sufficient time to work out the settlement.

Legal counsel for EPA Region I, Kathleen Woodward, has indicated that she has no objections to this extension of time in which to answer the Administrative Complaint, until December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

II. AUTHORITY TO GRANT AN EXTENSION


The Presiding Officer may grant an extension of time for filing any document, including a written answer to an administrative complaint, upon timely motion of a party to the proceeding, for good cause shown, and after consideration of prejudice to other parties, under the Consolidated Rules of Practice, 40 C.F. R. 22.7(b). This Motion is made in advance of the due date of October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2009 to allow

other parties to respond and to allow the Presiding Officer to issue an Order, especially in light of the acquiescence of EPA counsel to issuance of the requested extension.

### III. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Because there is no prejudice to any other party and there is good cause for an extension of time to which to file an Answer to the Administrative Complaint, the Town of Plaistow, respectfully requests that the time for filing an Answer to this Complaint be extended until December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2009.



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
