Respondent respectfully requests an extension of time to file an Answer to the abovecaptioned Complaint based on the following circumstances:

- 1. On October 11, 2007, Respondent filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File an Answer and Proposed Order, requesting additional time to permit a settlement conference to occur.
- 2. By Order dated October 15, 2007, Respondent was granted an extension through and including December 4, 2007.
- 3. On November 20, 2007, Respondent and Complainant met at the USEPA Region 2 offices and discussed possible settlement terms, including Respondent's possible performance of a Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP). However, despite progress, the parties require additional time to finalize the terms and conditions of an acceptable settlement agreement. Specifically, Respondent requires additional time to identify and formulate a SEP that is acceptable to Complainant as a condition of settlement and Complainant will require time for SEP review and approval.
- 4. Prior to filing this motion, counsel for Complainant indicated his consent to the proposed extension time.

WHEREFORE, Respondent, Evans Chemetics, LP, respectfully requests that this Motion for Extension of Time to File an Answer and Proposed Order be granted, thereby extending Respondent's time to file an Answer through and including Thursday, January 31, 2008. If, despite all reasonable and good faith measures, Respondent and Complainant are unable to finalize an agreement by this date, Respondent will advise you in a timely manner if an additional extension of time will be requested.
