EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

for violating 40 CFR § 68.67, 40 CFR § 68.69 and Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act.

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 4, the Director of the Air, Pesticides and Toxics Management Division (Complainant), and by the City of Smyrna, Tennessee (Respondent), pursuant to Section 113(a)(3) and (d) of the Clean Air Act (the "Act"), 42 U.S.C. § 7413(a)(3) and (d), and pursuant to 40 CFR § 22.13(b).

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

Based on a compliance monitoring inspection conducted at the Respondent's Water Treatment Plant located at 156 Sharp Springs Road, Smyrna, Tennessee, on October 18, 2007, EPA alleges that the Respondent violated the Act's Chemical Accident Prevention Program when Respondent did not provide evidence that:

- 1. It had performed a process hazard analysis using a team with expertise in engineering and process operations to identify, evaluate and control process hazards as required by 40 C.F.R § 68.67(a).
- 2. It had developed written operating procedures which address the following:

Steps for each operating phase:

(a) Emergency shutdown including the conditions under which emergency shutdown is required, and the assignment of shutdown responsibility to qualified operators to ensure that emergency shutdown is executed in a safe and timely manner (40 CFR § 68.69(a)(1)(iv)), and

(b) Startup following a turnaround, or after an emergency shutdown (40 CFR § 68.69(a)(1)(vii)); and

Safety and Health Considerations:

- (a) Properties of, and hazards presented by process chemicals (40 CFR § 68.69(a)(3)(i))), and
- (b) Control measures to be taken if physical contact or airborne exposure occurs (40 CFR § 68.69(a)(3)(iii)).
- 3. It has annually certified that operating procedures are current and accurate (40 C.F.R § 68.69(c)).

SETTLEMENT

In consideration of Respondent's size, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violations cited above, for the total penalty amount of \$1080.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions: the Respondent by signing below admits the jurisdictional allegations contained herein, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above; Respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C § 7413(d)(2)(A), and to contest the allegations contained in this ESA; and each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.

Respondent certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that the Respondent has corrected the alleged violations listed in this ESA. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$1080. Please note that payment should not be made until after Respondent receives a copy of the fully executed ESA. Within fifteen (15) days after receiving a copy of the fully executed ESA, the Respondent shall send a cashier's check or certified check (payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America") in the amount of \$1080, in payment of the full penalty amount to one of the following addresses:

For payment sent via overnight mail service (FedEx, UPS)

At the time of payment, Respondent shall send a separate copy of the check, and a written statement that payment has been made in accordance with this ESA to:
