- EPA filed the Administrative Complaint and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing (Complaint) in this matter on December 14, 2007
- On December 21, 2007, the Three Affiliated Tribes (Tribes) accepted service for the Complaint.
- 3. In accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 22.15(a) of the Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties, Issuance of Compliance or Corrective Action Orders, and the Revocation, Termination or Suspension of Permits

Highway 8 Convenience Store Motion for Extension of Time - Page 1 (Consolidated Rules), answers to complaints must be filed with the Regional Hearing Clerk within thirty (30) days after service of the complaint.

- 4. Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.7, Computation and extension of time, the Respondent's answer to the Complaint was due January 24, 2008.
- 5. On January 24, 2008, the parties discussed the status of Respondent Three Affiliated Tribes' answer and the difficulties encountered by the Tribes' attorney in collecting documentation in support of the answer despite good faith efforts due to the holidays. Respondent Three Affiliated Tribes requested a two-week extension of time to file its answer.
- 6. This Motion is timely filed, will not prejudice the Complainant, and is based on good cause.

WHEREFORE, the Parties jointly seek an extension of two weeks up to and including February 7, 2008, for Respondent Three Affiliated Tribes to answer or otherwise respond to the Complaint as permitted by 40 C.F.R. § 22.15.
