Dear Mayor Horn:

On September 19, 2007, the above referenced Findings of Violation and Order for Compliance on Consent was filed with the Regional Docket Clerk under the authority of Section 309(a)(3) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. §§ 1319(a)(3). On May 2, 2014, the EPA received the City of Buffalo's quarterly report covering the first quarter of calendar year 2014. The EPA has reviewed that report as well as previous reports received from the City, and has determined that the requirements of the Order have been adequately met. This letter serves as a notification to you that the EPA is terminating the Order as provided in Paragraph 54 of the Order. The EPA's decision to terminate the Order is conditioned upon the accuracy of your representations to the EPA in response to the requirements of the Order.

The effect of this termination is limited to the requirements imposed under the Order. The EPA reserves all of its authorities, both legal and equitable, under the CWA and any other statutory, regulatory, or common law authorities of the United States.
