INITIAL PREHEARING

Biro, Presiding Officer, and pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.19(a):

# Expert Witness.

Linnea J. Hansen, Scientist. Linnea J. Hansen received her Doctorate of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in Experimental Pathology from Northwestern University Medical School in Chicago, Illinois in 1984. Dr. Hansen has been employed as a Scientist in the Health Effects Division (Toxicology Branch) of the Office of Pesticide Programs at the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for the past 17 years. Dr. Hansen will testify regarding the health effects of exposure to sodium hypochlorite generally and the hazards posed by "Bref Disinfectant with Densicloro®" specifically.

# Fact Witness.

2. Julie Jordan, Environmental Protection Specialist. Julie Jordan will testify regarding the development of the complaint on file in the action. Ms. Jordan will be available to respond to questions regarding the calculation of the proposed civil penalty.

# Documentary Evidence.

The list of documentary evidence and exhibits intended to be introduced into evidence, and copies thereof, are attached.

### Place of Hearing.

4. Complainant's First Choice is San Francisco, California. Complainant estimates that one day will suffice to present its direct case.

### Statements Required by Judge.

- 5. No translation services will be necessary for testimony.
- 6. A copy of Complainant's Penalty Calculation Worksheet is attached as CX 12. The Penalty Calculation Worksheet tracks the FIFRA Enforcement Response Policy. The Affidavit of Julie Jordan contains the detail of how the proposed penalty amount was calculated in accordance with the criteria set forth in FIFRA. Ms. Jordan's Affidavit will be offered into the record in lieu of direct testimony. Ms. Jordan will be available for questions from the Presiding Administrative Law Judge and cross examination by counsel for Respondent regarding the penalty calculation.
- 7. The Paperwork Reduction Act (the "PRA") has no effect on this case for the following reasons. First, the PRA does not apply to prohibitions on activity such as a prohibition on the distribution of an unregistered pesticide. The PRA applies to certain record keeping and information collection requirements imposed by a federal agency. Second, to the extent that information collection activities took place during the investigation underlying this enforcement action, these information collection activities fall outside the scope of the PRA because the PRA does not apply to the collection of information during the conduct of an administrative action or investigation against specific individuals or entities. See 44 U.S.C. §§ 3502(3) (B) and 3518(c)(1)(B)(ii). Consequently, there is no current Office of Management and Budget control number involved in this case, and Section 3512 of the Paperwork Reduction Act is not applicable in this

case.
