ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE PREHEARING EXCHANGES

On October 23, 2009 Respondent filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Prehearing Exchanges. In support of its motion, Respondent states that the parties have engaged in settlement negotiations, but require additional time to organize Respondent's financial documents. Complainant does not oppose this motion.

Based on the parties' representations, the Motion is GRANTED. The Prehearing Exchange will be postponed while the parties work towards a Consent Agreement and Final Order ("CAFO"). Complainant is directed to file a Status Report by January 7, 2010, if the matter is not fully resolved by the execution of the CAFO by that time. The new schedule for the prehearing exchange is as follows: Complainant's initial exchange is due February 10, 2010; Respondent's initial exchange is due March 10, 2010; and Complainant's rebuttal, if any, is due March 25, 2010.
