Respondent respectfully requests an extension of time to file an Answer to the above-captioned Complaint based on the following circumstances:

- 1. On January 29, 2008, Respondent filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File an Answer and Proposed Order, requesting additional time to permit the parties to finalize settlement terms, including the performance of a Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP).
- 2. By Order dated January 31, 2008, Respondent was granted an extension through and including April 4, 2008.
- 3. On January 28, 2008, Respondent, in response to Complainant's request, submitted vendor quotes for the equipment Respondent proposes to purchase for the local emergency planning committee (LEPC) for its use in responding to emergencies. On January 30, 2008, again in response to Complainant's request, Respondent provided a letter from the LEPC indicating how the LEPC intends to use the shelters that are proposed to be purchased by Respondent as part of the SEP. On February 6, 2008, Complainant indicated that it had approved Respondent's proposed SEP and that it would calculate the amount of the SEP cost that would be applied to the agreed upon payable penalty. On March 19, 2008, Complainant provided to Respondent a draft Consent Agreement and Final Order (CA/FO) for comment. Respondent and Complainant need additional time to finalize the CA/FO.

4. Prior to filing this motion, counsel for Complainant indicated his consent to the proposed extension of time to file an Answer.

WHEREFORE, Respondent, Evans Chemetics, LP, respectfully requests that this Motion for Extension of Time to File an Answer and Proposed Order be granted, thereby extending Respondent's time to file an Answer through and including June 4, 2008.
