Consent Agreement and Final Order

Preliminary Statement

- 1. Complainant, the Director of the Land and Chemicals Division, Unites States
 Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 5, brought this administrative action seeking a
 civil penalty under Section 16(a) of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), 15 U.S.C.
 § 2615(a).
- 2. On September 12, 2011, EPA filed the Complaint in this action against Respondent Babic Rental Ventures, LLC (Respondent). The Complaint alleges that Respondent violated Section 1018(b)(5) of the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992, 42 U.S.C. § 4852d(b)(5); Section 409 of TSCA, 15 U.S.C. § 2689; and 40 C.F.R. §§ 745.113(b)(1), 745.113(b)(2), 745.113(b)(3), 745.113(b)(4) and 745.113(b)(5) in six contracts to lease target housing.
 - 3. Respondent filed an Answer and requested a hearing in this matter.

Stipulations

- 4. Respondent admits the jurisdictional allegations in the Complaint and neither admits nor denies the factual allegations in the Complaint other than those admitted in its Answer.
- 5. Respondent waives any right to contest the allegations in the Complaint and its right to appeal this Consent Agreement and Final Order (CAFO).
- 6. Respondent certifies that it is complying fully with the Residential Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 and the regulations at 40 C.F.R. Part 745.
- 7. Respondent consents to the assessment of the civil penalty stated in this CAFO and to the terms of this CAFO.
- 8. The parties agree that settling this action without further litigation, upon the terms of this CAFO, is in the public interest.

Civil Penalties

- 9. In consideration of the cooperation displayed by the Respondent, the immediate efforts taken to comply with the Disclosure Rule, Respondent's performance of a lead-based paint testing and visual assessment in accordance with HUD guidelines on January 5-7, 2011, (the Lead Inspection) and the manner in which the parties reached settlement in this matter, EPA agrees to mitigate the proposed penalty of \$32,555 to \$16,557.
- 10. Within 30 days after the effective date of this CAFO, Respondent must pay the \$16,557 civil penalty by sending a cashier's or certified check, payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America, to:

11. Respondent must send a notice of payment that states Respondent's name, complete address, the case docket number and the billing document to EPA at the following addresses when it pays the penalty:

- 12. This civil penalty is not deductible for tax purposes.
- 13. If Respondent does not pay timely the civil penalty, EPA may refer this matter to the Attorney General who will recover such amount, plus interest, in the appropriate district court of the United States under Section 16(a) of TSCA, 15 U.S.C. § 2615(a). The validity, amount and appropriateness of the civil penalty are not reviewable in a collection action.
- 14. Pursuant to 31 C.F.R. § 901.9, Respondent must pay the following on any amount overdue under this CAFO. Interest will accrue on any amount overdue from the date payment was due at a rate established by the Secretary of the Treasury. Respondent must pay a \$15 handling charge each month that any portion of the penalty is more than 30 days past due. In

addition, Respondent must pay a 6 percent per year penalty on any principal amount 90 days past due.

Additional Provision

15. Respondent shall provide a copy of the January 5-7, 2011, Lead Inspection to each current tenant of the residential apartment building at 2615 West Boulevard, Belleville, Illinois, and to all future tenants prior to the tenant signing a lease for rental of an apartment at 2615 West Boulevard, Belleville, Illinois.

General Provisions

- 16. This CAFO resolves only Respondent's liability for civil penalties for the violations alleged in the Complaint.
- 17. This CAFO does not affect the right of EPA or the United States to pursue appropriate injunctive or other equitable relief or criminal sanctions for any violation of law.
- 18. This CAFO does not affect Respondent's responsibility to comply with TSCA, the Lead-Based Hazard Reduction Act of 1992 and other applicable federal, state and local laws.
 - 19. The terms of the CAFO bind the Respondent and its successors and assigns.
- 20. Each person signing this Consent Agreement certifies that he or she has the authority to sign this Consent Agreement for the party whom he or she represents and to bind that party to its terms.
 - 21. Each party agrees to bear its own costs and fees in this action.
 - 22. This CAFO constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties.
