# for violating 40 CFR § 68.65, 40 CFR § 68.69, 40 CFR § 68.71, and Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act.

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 4, the Director of the Air, Pesticides and Toxics Management Division (Complainant), and by the Columbia, Tennessee, Board of Public Utilities (Respondent), pursuant to Section 113(a)(3) and (d) of the Clean Air Act (the "Act"), 42 U.S.C. § 7413(a)(3) and (d), and pursuant to 40 CFR § 22.13(b).

#### ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

Based on a compliance monitoring inspection conducted at the Respondent's Water System Filter Plant located at 806 Nashville Highway, Columbia, Tennessee, on February 28, 2008, EPA alleges that the Respondent violated the Act's Chemical Accident Prevention Program when Respondent did not provide evidence that:

As part of its safety information documentation, it has compiled and maintained the following information pertaining to the technology of the process as required by 40 CFR 68.65(c)(1): (iv) safe upper and lower limits for such items as temperatures, pressures, flows, or compositions; and (v) an evaluation of the consequences of deviation;

As part of its safety information documentation, it has complied and maintained the following information pertaining to the equipment in the process as required by 40 CFR § 68.65(d)(1): (i) materials of construction; (iii) electrical classification; (v) ventilation system design; (vi) design codes and standards employed, and (viii) safety systems (e.g., interlocks, detection or suppression systems);

It has annually certified that its operating procedures are current and accurate as required by 40 CFR § 68.69(c); and

It has prepared a record of training on operating procedures (refresher training is required at least every three years) which contains the identity of the employee, the date of training and the means used to verify that the employee understood the training as required by 40 C.F.R § 68.71(c).

#### **SETTLEMENT**

In consideration of Respondent's size, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violations cited above, for the total penalty amount of **\$1920**.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions: the Respondent by signing below admits the jurisdictional allegations contained herein, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above; Respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C § 7413(d)(2)(A), and to contest the allegations contained in this ESA; and each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.

Respondent certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that the Respondent has corrected the alleged violations listed in this ESA. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of **\$1920**. Please note that payment should not be made until after Respondent receives a copy of the fully executed ESA. Within fifteen (15) days after receiving a copy of the fully executed ESA, the Respondent shall send a cashier's check or certified check (payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America") in the amount of **\$1920**, in payment of the full penalty amount to one of the following addresses:
