



EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT (ESA)

DOCKET NO.: CAA-07-2024-0062 **This ESA is issued to**: Five Star Cooperative **At**: 16682A 245th St., Mason City, Iowa 50401 for violating Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 7 (EPA or Complainant) and Five Star Cooperative (Respondent), have agreed to a settlement of this action before filing of a complaint, and thus this action is simultaneously commenced and concluded pursuant to Rules 22.13(b) and 22.18(b)(2) of the Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties and the Revocation/Termination or Suspension of Permits (Consolidated Rules), 40 C.F.R. §§ 22.13(b), 22.18(b)(2).

Complainant, as duly delegated by the Administrator of the EPA, is the Director of the Region 7 Enforcement and Compliance Assurance Division. Respondent is Five Star Cooperative, an Iowa company registered to do business in Iowa and whose registered office in Iowa is located at 1949 North Linn Avenue (P.O. Box 151), New Hampton, Iowa 50659.

This is an administrative action for the assessment of civil penalties instituted pursuant to Section 113(d) of the Clean Air Act (CAA). Pursuant to Section 113(d) of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(d), the Administrator and the Attorney General jointly determined that cases which meet the criteria set forth in EPA's policies entitled "Use of Expedited Settlements in Addressing Violations of the Clean Air Act Chemical Accident Prevention Provisions, 40 C.F.R. Part 68," dated January 5, 2004, and "Changes to Restrictions on the Use of Expedited Settlements in Addressing Violations of the Clean Air Act Chemical Accident Prevention Provisions," dated December 20, 2013, are appropriate for administrative penalty actions.

ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

On or about August 8, 2023, Tetra Tech, Inc., as a representative of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, conducted a compliance inspection of Respondent's facility located at 16682A 245th Street, Mason City, Iowa 50401 to determine compliance with the Chemical Accident Prevention Provisions (CAPP), commonly known as the Risk Management Program regulations, promulgated pursuant to Section 112(r)(7) of the CAA and found at Title 40 of the code of federal regulations_at 40 C.F.R. Part 68. The EPA found that the Respondent had violated the CAPP as noted on the enclosed CAPP Inspection Findings, which is hereby incorporated by reference.

SETTLEMENT

In consideration of Respondent's size of business, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record, the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violations, described in the enclosed CAPP Inspection Findings, for the total penalty amount of **\$360**.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions:

Respondent, by signing below, waives any objections that it may have regarding jurisdiction, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein and in the CAPP Inspection Findings, consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above. Respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the CAA, 42 U.S.C. § 7413(d)(2)(A), and to appeal this ESA. Each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any. Respondent also certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that Respondent has corrected the violations listed in the enclosed CAPP Information Request Findings and has paid the penalty of \$360.

Penalty payment shall identify Respondent by name and docket number and shall be by electronic payment method described at *http://www.epa.gov/financial/makepayment* or by alternate method of certified or cashier's check made payable to the "United States Treasury" and sent to:

Full payment of the ESA penalty shall only resolve Respondent's liability for federal civil penalties for the violations alleged in the CAPP Inspection Findings. The EPA reserves the right to take any enforcement action for any other violations of the CAA or any other statute.

This ESA is binding on the parties signing below.

This ESA is effective upon filing with the Regional Hearing Clerk.
