FINAL DECISION

I have reviewed the Recommended Decision of the Regional Judicial Officer dated December 15, 1995, and the comments on it filed by the parties to this proceeding pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 24.12(c).

I hereby adopt the attached Regional Judicial Officer's

Recommended Decision, as modified by the following changes, as my

Final Decision in this matter:

- 1. On page 25 of the Recommended Decision, line 9 of the first paragraph should read "was to be co-extensive with that of $\S 3004(u)$ ", instead of $\S 3008(h)$.
- 2. On page 29, the second paragraph numbered 8 shall be renumbered paragraph 9, and numbers of the subsequent paragraphs shall be accordingly changed to 10 12.
- 3. On page 29, paragraph 12 shall be changed to read "Paragraph Z shall be modified to delete reference to the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality."

I further order that the Administrative Order, as modified by the Recommended Decision, be issued as a Final Order with the following changes:

1. On page 10 a new paragraph X shall be added after W which states . . . "The actions required by this order are deemed necessary to protect human health and the environment."

- 2. On page 11, [of] shall be deleted from the beginning third line of paragraph 8.a.
- 3. On page 12, [an] shall be deleted from the end of the second line in the first paragraph.
- 4. On page 21, "and/or WDEQ representatives" shall be deleted from the fifth line of paragraph 5.

The Assistant Regional Administrator, Office of Enforcement, Compliance and Environmental Justice shall modify the order in accordance with the terms of this Final Decision and file and serve a copy of the Final Administrative Order, on the Respondent.

The Final Decision and the Final Administrative Order are final agency actions that are effective on filing and service. The actions are not appealable to the Administrator.
