## EXPEDITED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

**DOCKET NO: CAA-04-2011-8014(b)** 

This ESA is issued to: Airgas South

2610 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue North Bessemer, Alabama 35020

for violating 40 CFR § 68.65, 40 CFR § 68.69, 40 CFR § 68.87 and Section 112(r)(7) of the Clean Air Act.

This Expedited Settlement Agreement (ESA) is being entered into by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 4, the Director of the Air, Pesticides and Toxics Management Division (Complainant), and by Airgas South (Respondent), pursuant to Section 113(d) of the Clean Air Act (the "Act"), 42 U.S.C. § 7413(d), and pursuant to 40 CFR § 22.13(b).

#### ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

Based on a compliance monitoring inspection conducted at the Respondent's facility located at 2610 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue North, Bessemer, Alabama, on August 11, 2010, EPA alleges that the Respondent violated the Act's Chemical Accident Prevention Program when at the time of inspection, Respondent did not provide evidence that:

It had compiled information concerning the technology of the process including safe upper and lower limits for such items as temperatures, pressures, flows or compositions as required by 40 CFR § 68.65(c)(1)(iv);

It had compiled information pertaining to the equipment in the process including relief system design and design basis as required by 40 CFR § 68.65(d)(1)(iv);

It had developed and implemented written operating procedures that provide clear instructions for safely conducting activities involved in the covered process consistent with the process safety information, addressing the normal operations associated with trans-loading as required by 40 CFR § 68.69(a)(1)(ii); and

It had periodically evaluated the performance of the contract owner or operator in fulfilling their obligations under 40 CFR § 68.87(c) as required by 40 CFR § 68.87(b)(5).

#### SETTLEMENT

In consideration of Respondent's size, its full compliance history, its good faith effort to comply, and other factors as justice may require, and upon consideration of the entire record the parties enter into the ESA in order to settle the violation cited above, for the total penalty amount of \$1,800.

This settlement is subject to the following terms and conditions: the Respondent by signing below admits the jurisdictional allegations contained herein, neither admits nor denies the specific factual allegations contained herein, and consents to the assessment of the penalty as stated above; Respondent waives its rights to a hearing afforded by Section 113(d)(2)(A) of the Act, 42 U.S.C § 7413(d)(2)(A), and to contest the allegations contained in this ESA; and each party to this action shall bear its own costs and fees, if any.

Respondent certifies, subject to civil and criminal penalties for making a false submission to the United States Government, that the Respondent has corrected the alleged violation listed in this ESA. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of \$1,800. Please note that payment should not be made until after Respondent receives a copy of the fully executed ESA. Within fifteen (15) days of receiving a copy of the fully executed ESA, the Respondent shall send a cashier's check or certified check (payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America") in the amount of \$1,800, in payment of the full penalty amount to one of the following addresses:

The Respondent's name and the Docket Number of this ESA <u>must be included on the check</u>. The Docket Number is located at the top left corner of the first page of this ESA.
