



East Mission Flats Waste Repository: Enhanced Monitoring Plan Open House October 29, Canyon School



Public Input Due by November 12, 2009

Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) are preparing an “Enhanced Monitoring Plan” for the East Mission Flats Repository. The plan is being completed in response to the EPA Office of Inspector General’s recommendation.

It will outline the agencies’ plans to monitor moisture conditions within the repository and water levels in the ground below the repository.

Because the Enhanced Monitoring Plan is a key outcome of the Inspector General review process, the agencies would like to get public input on its development. To give the public more time to review the plan, EPA has requested an extension to the deadline for submitting it to the IG. Public review of the draft plan will be October 13 – November 12.

Come to the open house on **October 29**, at the Canyon School, E. 27491 School House Loop, Cataldo, ID 83810. Drop in any time between **4:30 and 7:30 p.m.** View displays, talk with DEQ and EPA project managers, learn more about the Enhanced Monitoring Plan and the Office of Inspector General review. There will be no formal presentations.
