Ketchikan Pulp Company Project: EPA's Review Finds Past Cleanup Is Protective

EPA (U.S. Environmental Protection Agency) has completed a "five-year review" of the Ketchikan Pulp Company (KPC) Project in Ketchikan, Alaska. This review looked at the hazardous-waste cleanup of the land formerly owned by KPC. It also looked at the cleanup of contaminated sediments in Ward Cove. The cleanups were done from 1998 to 2001.

EPA's review confirmed that the cleanups and controls are working and that people and the environment are protected. No significant issues were identified.
