1. Page 1-1, Correction. The Navy conducted the 2nd Five Year Review from September 2004 to February 2005.
2. Five Year Review Summary Form, Correction. The review period should be September 30, 2000 to February 2, 2005.
3. Page 1-2, Correction. The references cited should be Navy 2004 and USEPA 2001.
4. Discontinuation of Shellfish and Sediment Monitoring, Clarification. The Washington Department of Ecology, the agency providing lead regulatory oversight at the site agreed with the Navy's recommendation to discontinue the shellfish and sediment monitoring, *Ecology Ltr Revised Evaluation of Shellfish and Sediment Monitoring at Site 10 Naval Magazine Indian Island, Jefferson County, Washington, January 18, 2002*. The Point-No-Point Treaty Council, the tribal organization with Usual and Accustom treaty rights for Indian Island, also agreed with the Navy's recommendation to discontinue the shellfish and sediment monitoring, *Point No Point Treaty Council Ltr, Revised Evaluation of Shellfish and Sediment Monitoring at Site 10 Naval Magazine Indian Island, December 6, 2001*.
5. Clarification. Changes in monitoring frequencies and parameters referenced in this 2nd Five Year Review were approved by the Washington Department of Ecology, the agency providing lead regulatory oversight at the site. *Ecology Ltr Revised Evaluation of Shellfish and Sediment Monitoring at Site 10 Naval Magazine Indian Island, Jefferson County, Washington, January 18, 2002*.
6. Section 5.0 and Table 5-1. On November 18, 2004, the Navy, Washington Department of Ecology, and USEPA executed an *Explanation of Significant Differences*, which clarified requirements, roles and responsibilities regarding Institutional Controls. Institutional Control implementation, maintenance, evaluation, and reporting requirements are further detailed in *Naval Magazine Indian Island Instruction 5090.13A – Land Use Controls/Institutional Controls, March 8, 2005*.
7. Section 6.6. Correction. EPA and Washington Department of Ecology chose not to be interviewed in the preparation of this 2nd Five-year Review.
