 **Review Confirms People and Environment Are  
Protected by Queen City Farms Superfund Cleanup**

THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) has completed a Five-Year Review of the Queen City Farms Superfund cleanup on Cedar Grove Road in Maple Valley, Washington. The review confirms that the cleanup continues to protect people and the environment. Overall, the cap/cover system is working well. Monitoring results show that the vertical barrier wall is performing as designed. EPA plans to evaluate plant growth, especially Scotch broom, on the cap. If the plants threaten the integrity of the cap, they will be removed.
