## JUDGMENT

The petitioner has filed a petition for review of a decision issued on May 28, 2010 by the Environmental Appeals Board of the United States Environmental Protection Agency. On October 12, 2010, we ordered the petitioner and respondent to address the stage of the administrative proceedings and whether this petition should be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. Having reviewed the parties' responses to our order to show cause and the parties' subsequent filings, we <u>dismiss</u> this appeal for lack of jurisdiction. <u>See</u> 33 U.S.C. § 1369(b)(1)(F) (providing for review of "the Administrator's action . . . in issuing or denying any permit under section 1342 of this title"); 40 C.F.R. § 124.19(f)(1) ("For purposes of judicial review . . . final agency action occurs when a final . . . NPDES . . . permit decision is issued by EPA and agency review procedures under this section are exhausted."); see also Rhode Island v. <u>EPA</u>, 378 F.3d 19, 22-23 (1st Cir. 2004).

As this court lacks jurisdiction, the Upper Blackstone Water Pollution Abatement District's Motions to Amend the Caption and For Leave to Intervene in Support of Respondent are <u>denied as</u> <u>moot</u>.
