

**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FURTHER BRIEFING**

By order dated June 16, 2008, the Environmental Appeals Board requested additional briefing on specific issues identified in the order. The order established Wednesday, July 16, 2008, as the due date for U.S. EPA Region 8 ("Region") and EPA's Office of Air and Radiation ("OAR") to jointly file a responsive brief. The order also specified that any party, or interested person that has previously participated in this proceeding as an amicus, may file a response to the Region/OAR's brief on or before Friday, August 15, 2008.

Before the Board at this time is a motion filed by the Region and OAR requesting an extension of the above-referenced briefing due dates. The motion requests that the Region's and OAR's brief be due on Friday, August 8, 2008, and that response briefs be due on Friday, September 12, 2008. They represent in the motion that additional time is needed to compile information requested in the Board's order. In addition, the Region and OAR state that the petitioner (Sierra Club) and the permittee (Deseret Power Electric Cooperative) have stated that they do not oppose the requested extension of time.

Upon consideration, the Board hereby grants the Region's and OAR's request for an extension of the due dates provided in the Board's June 16, 2008 order. The Region/OAR's brief responding to that order shall be due on or before Friday, August 8, 2008. In addition, any party, or interested person that has previously participated in this proceeding as an amicus, may file a response to the Region/OAR's brief on or before Friday, Friday, September 12, 2008.


