SECOND ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS
TO ALLOW PARTIES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BOARD'S
ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION PROGRAM

The parties in the above-captioned matter, City of Holyoke Department of Public Works and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 1, have agreed to participate in the Environmental Appeals Board's Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) program. In light of this agreement, the Board issued an order staying all proceedings until June 3, 2024.

The settlement judge has notified the panel that an extension of the stay in this proceeding is warranted to accommodate ADR sessions scheduled for mid-August 2024. Accordingly, all proceedings in this matter are stayed until Wednesday, August 28, 2024.
