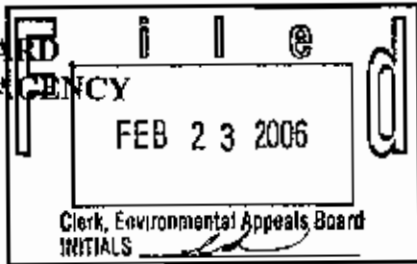

SECOND ORDER GRANTING STAY

On December 15, 2005, Wasatch Propane, Inc. ("Wasatch"), filed its Notice of Appeal from a Default Order/Initial Decision issued on November 15, 2005. On January 18, 2006, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 8 filed its appellate brief in reply to Wasatch's appeal. On January 19, 2006, Wasatch filed a motion stating that the parties have reached an agreement in principle to settle this matter in full and requesting a 30-day stay of this appeal. The Board granted that request by order dated January 21, 2006. The parties have now filed a joint request that we extend the stay for an additional 20 days.

For good cause shown, this appeal is hereby stayed until Monday, March 13, 2006.


