ORDER

Before the Court is the Parties’ Joint Motion to Temporarily Stay Proceedings (Dkt. 151) (the “Motion”). For good cause shown, the Court **GRANTS** the Motion **IN PART**, as set forth herein:


1. All trial-related deadlines as set forth in the Order Granting the Parties' Joint Motion to Enter Eighth Amended Case Management Scheduling Order (Dkt. 149), with the exception of the trial setting, are temporarily stayed for 60 days so that the Parties may continue advanced settlement discussions;

2. All rulings on the Parties' pending dispositive motions, *Daubert* motions, and motions in limine (Dkts. 125, 126, 127, 129, 130, 131, 132, and 133) are also stayed for 60 days in order to facilitate such settlement discussions;

3. At the conclusion of settlement discussions or the end of the 60-day period, whichever comes sooner, the Parties will jointly report to the Court on the status of this matter; and

4. In the event the Parties are unable to reach a settlement, such report will include a proposal for scheduling the trial and trial-related deadlines, as well as logistics for trial, in consideration of further developments in the COVID-19 situation.
