Although the unit pictured appears to be reasonably sturdy and is illustrated as being locked, the unit does not appear to be capable of preventing a child from reaching through the rodent entrances and into the bait compartment. EPA considers use of this illustration to be a short-term compromise approach at best, to serve until standard bait station language is released for incorporation into labels for all baits registered to control consensual rodents. Do not want the bait station illustration on your label to attain status as a valid depiction of a "TAMPER-PROOF BAIT BOX." As the current picture is better than no illustration, it should remain for now, but with the caption deleted.
