

ORDER GRANTING REGION'S REQUEST TO FILE A SUR-REPLY

On December 31, 2008, the permit issuer in the above captioned matter, U.S. EPA Region 1 ("Region 1"), requested the opportunity to submit a "brief sur-reply," to Upper Blackstone Water Pollution District's ("District") reply brief, which is due on February 16, 2009. On February 11, 2009, the Environmental Appeal Board ("Board") issued an order allowing another petitioner in the above captioned matter, the Conservation Law Foundation ("CLF"), to submit a reply brief.

Upon consideration, the Board hereby grants the Region's request to file a short sur-reply to the District's reply brief and, if the Region so desires, to CLF's reply brief. The brief

must not exceed 25 pages in length.¹ The Region must file its sur-reply no later than Monday, March 9, 2009.²
