

ORDER GRANTING FIFTH MOTION FOR CONTINUATION OF STAY

On July 26, 2007, Region IV of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency filed a motion with the Environmental Appeals Board seeking a continuation of the stay in the above-captioned proceedings until August 11, 2007. Region IV reports that the State of South Carolina issued the water quality certification for the pending permit on July 23, 2007, and that the only task yet to complete is issuance of the final permit incorporating the changes negotiated with Easley Combined Utilities, petitioner and permittee. The Region reports that it expects to issue the final permit sometime during the week of July 30, 2007.

For good cause shown, we hereby **GRANT** the motion. The Region is now required to file its response to Easley's pending petition for review on or before **Monday**, **August 13**, **2007**. So ordered.
