ORDER GRANTING STAY

On October 30, 2020, a consortium of groups, including Center for Food Safety, Friends of the Earth, Recirculating Farms, Tampa Bay Waterkeeper, Suncoast Waterkeeper, Healthy Gulf, Sierra Club Florida, the Center for Biological Diversity, and Food & Water Watch (referred to collectively as "Petitioners") petitioned the Environmental Appeals Board ("Board") to review a Clean Water Act ("CWA") National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") permit decision by U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 4 ("Region").

By Motion filed on March 22, 2021, the Region seeks a 60-day stay of proceedings, until May 31, 2021, to allow the Region to fully brief the new Administration officials so that an informed decision can be made prior to the filing of a status report currently due on March 31, 2021. *See* Motion for Stay of Proceedings. In support of the motion, the Region explains that "due to the number of matters on which the new Administration is being briefed, the Region is not able to fully and adequately brief new Administration officials" within the time by which the status report is currently due. *Id.* at 2. The Region states further that "[t]he requested stay will allow the Agency to take actions in this case in a manner consistent with the policies and

directions in the Board's Order and in the Agency's Executive Order." *Id.* The Region represents that Petitioners do not object to the motion. *Id.*

Based on the Region's representations, the Board **GRANTS** the motion to stay this matter until June 1, 2021. The Region must file a status report with the Board no later than **June 1, 2021** informing the Board whether the Board should proceed with deliberations on this matter, including whether to set this matter for oral argument.¹

So ordered.
