

represents that it “plans to coordinate with multiple attorneys in several specialized disciplines within the Region and across the Agency.” *Id.* at 1-2. Additionally, the Region represents that the administrative records for the permits are “voluminous and contain personally identifiable information that the Region plans to redact and handle securely.” *Id.* According to the Region, the Petitioners and Permittee do not object to or oppose the Motion. *Id.* at 2.


The Board **GRANTS** the Motion. *See* 40 C.F.R. § 124.19(f)(6), (n). The Region shall file its response to the petition for review on or before **Thursday, April 25, 2024**. The Region must file a certified index of the administrative record and the relevant portions of the administrative record on or before the same date. *See id.* § 124.19(b)(2). The same deadline applies to the Permittee should it choose to file a response to the petition for review. *Id.* § 124.19(b)(3). Additionally, if they choose to participate, States or Tribal authorities where the permitted facility is located must file a notice of appearance and a response to the petition with the Board on or before **Thursday, April 25, 2024**. *See id.* § 124.19(b)(4).

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 124.19(i)(3)(iii), the Board may use email (Clerk_EAB@epa.gov) to serve orders and decisions in this matter to the addresses provided by the parties. Additionally, the Board has authorized all parties in permit appeals to use email to fulfill their service obligations under 40 C.F.R. § 124.19(i)(3)(ii). *See* Env’t Appeals Bd., U.S. EPA, *Revised Order Authorizing Electronic Service of Documents in Permit and Enforcement Appeals* (Sept. 21, 2020). The parties shall promptly notify the Board and the other parties of any change to their email address. The parties should continue to use the Board’s electronic filing system for filing all documents in this appeal.
