UNOPPOSED JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §124.19(g), Respondents US Wind, Inc. ("US Wind") and the Maryland Department of the Environment ("MDE") jointly request that the Environmental Appeals Board ("EAB") grant an eight day extension of time to file their respective replies to the briefs filed by Petitioners and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's ("EPA") Office of General Counsel and Region 3 on August 25, 2025.

Under the August 8, 2025, EAB Order Granting Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time, September 4, 2025, is currently the deadline for US Wind and MDE to file their replies. The undersigned parties seek an extension of this deadline to September 12, 2025. We are seeking this short extension to due to several factors: unavoidable scheduling conflicts on the part of US Wind's counsel, MDE counsel's resource constraints due to the fact that they (like US Wind) are simultaneously responding to multiple petitions for judicial review of the permit at issue in separate jurisdictions, the fact that the current reply period includes a holiday weekend, and the length of EPA's brief. To accommodate these considerations and ensure adequate time for internal

deliberations and briefings, US Wind and MDE request that the EAB extend the deadline to file the joint brief by eight days, from September 4 to September 12, 2025.

Consistent with 40 CFR § 124.19(f)(2), US Wind and MDE contacted counsel for the Petitioners and EPA. Neither Petitioners nor EPA oppose this motion.
