On behalf of the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management ("RIDEM"), I would like to extend my thanks to the Environmental Appeals Board ("the Board") for inviting RIDEM, as Amicus Curiae, to participate in oral argument on September 16, 2009, regarding the important issues raised in this matter. Please consider this letter as notice that RIDEM respectfully declines to attend and participate in the oral argument.
