AFFIDAVIT

- I, Michael B. (Mike) Owens, being first duly sworn, depose and state that the following statements set forth in this instrument are true and correct. To such matters, the undersigned certifies that he believes the same to be true:
- 1. I am employed by the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region 8 as an Environmental Engineer in the Office of Partnerships and Regulatory Assistance (OPRA), Air & Radiation Program, Air Technical Assistance Unit, located at 1595 Wynkoop Street, Denver, Colorado 80202-1129. I have been employed by the USEPA since August 1976.
- 2. As an Environmental Engineer for the Air and Radiation Program, my primary job responsibility is to oversee State air permitting programs and secondarily to write Federal air permits in Indian Country. In this regard, I am familiar with the various air emission units and pollution control technologies associated with the operation of coal-fired power plants. I am also familiar with the applicable environmental regulatory and permitting requirements for utility projects, including, but not limited to, the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) program. Among other things, I work closely with and at the direction of my supervisor, Melanie Pallman, Leader of the Air Technical Assistance Unit, to prepare draft and final versions of construction and operating permits. I am also involved in directing communications with permit applicants and interested persons in the permitting process, and researching, as necessary, available records and documents related to my review of permit applications and other associated work tasks.
- 3. As part of my responsibilities, I was assigned to review the Permit Application No. PSD-OU-0002-04.00, received from Deseret Power Electric Cooperative. Deseret proposed construction of a 110-Megawatt Waste Coal Fired Unit at Bonanza Power Plant, near the town of Bonanza, Utah, approximately 35 miles southeast of Vernal, UT. The application was received by US EPA Region 8 on April 13, 2004.

- 4. Since being assigned this application, I have maintained responsibility of the application file and have overseen management of all documents, as they were acquired, that related to the permit application. These documents include written correspondence and other documents needed to evaluate the permit application, as well as other related materials assembled by myself and other US EPA Region 8 personnel during the course of permit review.
- 5. Based on my review of the application file for the Deseret Power Electric Cooperative PSD permit, I have identified individual documents, including attachments thereto, and miscellaneous materials that were directly or indirectly relied upon by the US EPA Region 8 in review of the permit application and the resulting permit issuance.
