This letter is written on behalf of the Sandy Township Board of Supervisors. The Township borders Brady Township in Clearfield County and is in close proximity to the above listed proposed injection well.

The purpose of this letter is to serve as a letter of support to the Appeal filed by certain residents requesting the permit for the injection well be denied.

There are many well stated concerns cited in the Appeal of the residents and in the other letters of support submitted on behalf of the residents, including concerns about the potential contamination of underground water sources, the presence of old coal mines near the project site and the issue of open faults or fractures within the review area.

This injection well is located in close proximate to numerous residential homes, including homes in Sandy Township. The Supervisors previously voiced concern also about the potential for increased seismic activity as a result of the proposed injection well.
