The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 3, (“EPA”) issued the above-referenced Administrative Order to Idlewood Shores (“the System”) on August 5, 2025. In response to that Administrative Order, the System submitted the service line inventory as required by 40 C.F.R. §§ 141.84(a) and 141.90(e). EPA has also received information that the service line inventory is accessible to the public as required by 40 C.F.R. §§ 141.84(a)(5).

Pursuant to Section VI “Termination” of the Administrative Order, the EPA is informing you that the requirements of the Order have been met, and the EPA is terminating the Order as of the date of this letter.
