- 1. Complainant and the Town of Red River ("Respondent") (collectively, the "Parties") have reached a settlement in principle in the above-captioned matter. The settlement includes a Supplemental Environmental Project ("SEP") for restocking of native fish in segments of the Red River connected to the portion of the Red River affected by Respondent's unpermitted discharge.
- 2. Management personnel in the Compliance Assurance and Enforcement Division ("CAED") of Region 6 and personnel from the Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance ("OECA") at headquarters are currently evaluating the quality and appropriateness of the SEP. A CAFO will be provided to Respondent for signature following CAED and OECA approval (or disapproval) of the SEP.
- In the event settlement negotiations break down, Complainant will immediately provide the Regional Judicial Officer with an additional Status Report.
