The United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region 3 (“EPA”), issued the above-referenced Administrative Compliance Order (AOC) to the United States Army, Aberdeen Proving Ground – Edgewood Area (“Aberdeen”) on July 30, 2024. According to information provided to the EPA by Aberdeen, Aberdeen completed all requirements under the AOC by completing its Emergency Response Plan (“ERP”) and submitting its certification of completion of the ERP, as required by Section 1433(b) of the Safe Drinking Water Act (“SDWA”), 42 U.S.C. § 300i-2(b). Accordingly, pursuant to Paragraph 33 of the AOC, the EPA is confirming that Aberdeen completed the requirements of the Order, and the EPA is terminating the Order.

Please be advised that Aberdeen continues to be subject to Section 1433 of the SDWA, 42 U.S.C. § 300i-2 and as such is required to recertify the Risk and Resilience Assessment by June 30, 2026, and the ERP by December 31, 2026, to the EPA.
