This is an Addendum to the Administrative Order (Order) issued to Two Medicine Water Company on September 25, 2024. The purpose of this letter is to approve the Two Medicine Water Company's November 19, 2024, schedule (Schedule) for coming into consistent compliance with the significant deficiency violations. The Schedule is hereby incorporated into the Order pursuant to paragraph #13. Each milestone and deadline specified below is an enforceable provision of the Order.

The Order also requires Two Medicine Water Company to achieve and maintain compliance with the corrective action of the significant deficiencies requirements by the final date specified in the approved Schedule. The EPA is authorized to seek penalties if these deadlines are not met. If Two Medicine Water Company has a reasonable basis to believe it may be unable to meet any deadline in the Schedule, it must notify the EPA well in advance of the Scheduled deadline to request an extension. The EPA may, in its discretion, consider granting an extension.
