RESPONDENT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWER OR OTHERWISE RESPOND

Respondent, Coast to Coast Circuits, Inc. ("Coast to Coast"), by and through its counsel, Polsinelli PC, and for their Motion for Extension of Time to File Answer, states as follows:

- 1. The Complaint for this matter was filed on or about September 27, 2019, and received by Coast to Coast on or about October 3, 2019.
- 2. Following an informal conference with U.S. EPA, Coast to Coast filed its first Motion for Extension of Time to File Answer on or about October 18, 2019, which was granted by the Regional Hearing Officer on or about October 30, 2019 and set a deadline for Coast to Coast to file an Answer of December 13, 2019.
- 3. Following the Regional Hearing Officer's Order Granting An Extension Of Time To File An Answer To The Complaint, Coast to Coast retained undersigned counsel and engaged in good faith settlement discussions with U.S. EPA to resolve this matter, consisting of Coast to Coast providing documentation and additional information to U.S. EPA concerning its ability to pay and addressing the underlying allegations in the Complaint.
- 4. On December 10, 2019, with the consent of counsel for U.S. EPA, Coast to Coast filed its second Motion for Extension of Time to File Answer, which was granted by the

Regional Hearing Officer on December 11, 2019 and set a deadline for Coast to Coast to file an

Answer of January 27, 2020.

Coast to Coast and U.S. EPA are continuing to negotiate settlement of this matter 5.

in good faith, and Coast to Coast therefore respectfully requests an additional forty-five (45)

days from the current deadline to file an Answer, up to and including March 12, 2020, to file an

Answer or other responsive pleading to the Complaint. A proposed Order is attached as **Exhibit**

Coast to Coast has conferred with Assistant Regional Counsel for U.S. EPA and 6.

U.S. EPA is continuing to analyze the information provided by Coast to Coast in furtherance of

settlement negotiations and, therefore, U.S. EPA concurs with this Motion.

WHEREFORE, Respondent, Coast to Coast Circuits, Inc., respectfully requests that this

Honorable Regional Hearing Officer issue an order (a) granting Coast to Coast's motion for

extension of time, (b) ordering that Coast to Coast have up to and including March 12, 2020 to

file an Answer or submit responsive pleadings, and (c) granting such other and further relief as

the Court deems just.
