As stated in Section IV of the CAFO, the initial payment of \$213.95 of the assessed penalty of \$840 is due within 30 days from the effective date. CONSENT AGREEMENT AND FINAL ORDER

 This administrative proceeding for the assessment of a civil penalty was initiated pursuant to Section 14(a) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (hereinafter "FIFRA"), 7 U.S.C. § 136l(a). The action was instituted by a Civil Complaint and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing (hereinafter "Complaint"), which alleges that Spring Lake Gardens, Inc. (hereinafter "Respondent") violated FIFRA. Complainant and Respondent have entered into a settlement agreement to resolve these allegations. This Consent Agreement and Final Order (hereinafter "CAFO") embodies this settlement.

I. Consent Agreement

- 2. For the purposes of this CAFO, Respondent admits the jurisdictional allegations set forth in the Complaint and neither admits nor denies the factual allegations set forth in the Complaint.
- Respondent waives its right to a hearing on the allegations contained in the Complaint and its right to appeal the proposed final order accompanying the consent agreement.
- 4. Respondent consents to the assessment of and agrees to pay the civil penalty as set forth in this CAFO.

- 5. Compliance with this CAFO shall resolve the allegations of the violations contained in the Complaint. This CAFO shall not otherwise affect any liability of Respondent to the United States. Other than as expressed herein, neither EPA nor Complainant waives any right to bring an enforcement action against Respondent for violation of any federal or state statute, regulation or permit, to initiate an action for imminent and substantial endangerment, or to pursue criminal enforcement.
- 6. Complainant and Respondent agree to settle this matter by their execution of this CAFO. The parties agree that the settlement of this matter is in the public interest and that this CAFO is consistent with the applicable requirements of FIFRA.

IV. Final Order

7. Respondent is assessed a civil penalty of Eight Hundred Forty Dollars (\$840). Four payments will be made to complete payment of the entire civil penalty including interest. The first payment is due within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this CAFO and subsequent payments will be due in ninety (90) day intervals thereafter. Including the civil penalty and interest, the total amount that will be paid upon the completion of all payments will be Eight Hundred Fifty Five Dollars and Eighty Cents. Respondent shall make payments in accordance with the following schedule.

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8. Respondent shall remit each penalty payment by either a cashier's or certified check made payable to the "Treasurer, United States of America," and shall send the check via U.S. mail to the following address:

The check shall reference on its face the name of the Respondent and the Docket Number

assigned to this CAFO.

9. At the time of payment, Respondent shall send a separate copy of the check and a

written statement that the payment is being made in accordance with this CAFO, to the

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- 10. For the purposes of state and federal income taxation, Respondent shall not be entitled, and agrees not to attempt, to claim a deduction for any civil penalty payment made pursuant to this CAFO. Any attempt by Respondent to deduct any such payments shall constitute a violation of this CAFO.
- 11. Pursuant to 31 U.S.C. § 3717, EPA is entitled to assess interest and penalties on debts owed to the United States and a charge to cover the cost of processing and handling a delinquent claim. Interest will therefore begin to accrue on the civil penalty from the date of entry of this CAFO, if the penalty is not paid by the date required. A charge will also be assessed to cover the administrative costs, both direct and indirect, of overdue debts. In addition, a late payment penalty charge shall be applied on any principle amount not paid within 90 days of the due date.
- 12. Complainant and Respondent shall bear their own costs and attorney fees in this matter.
- 13. This CAFO shall be binding upon the Respondent, its successors and assigns.
- 14. The undersigned representative of the party to this CAFO certifies that he or she is fully authorized by the party represented to enter into this CAFO and legally binds that party to this CAFO.
