## MOTION FOR SITE VIEW

COMES NOW the Respondent, by and through counsel, Arthur S. Robinson, and moves for permission to make a site view of the Blossom property during the hearing currently scheduled to begin the week of May 3, 2004. Arrangements can be made by Respondent for the transportation of the Administrative Law Judge, attorneys for the parties, and the clerk/court reporter for such a visit.

A view of the site is absolutely necessary for the Administrative Law Judge to have a first-hand view of the site in question to put the alleged violation in context. A view of the site would provide a physical context for location and size of area under review and provide a clearer understanding of the issues and evidence presented at the hearing regarding the nature of the land and its proximity to navigable waters.

A motion for view of the site was not made earlier because at the time the hearing was set for both dates, including the May date, the Respondent did not believe that enough snow would

However, despite the very heavy snowfall from the past winter, a great deal of snow has melted in the area that would now make the viewing feasible and useful for the judge to have an understanding of facts surrounding the circumstances of the alleged violation. Normally, by the first week of May in the area in question there would be too much snow still to make site view useful.

The location of the Blossom property is approximately 30 minutes' drive from the location of the hearing in Kenai. The view itself would take approximately 45 minutes. There should be no need for continuation of the hearing to take less than a half day to view the site.

A site view was proposed during the April 22 prehearing conference and Mr. Kopf indicated that a motion would have to be made first requesting a site view.

This motion is supported by the accompanying affidavit of counsel.
