This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Administrative Order, Docket No. SDWA-08-2007-0057, issued to the Roman Catholic Bishop and the St. Labre Indian School, on June 4, 2007. The EPA has determined that the requirements of the Order have been met and therefore we will close it at this time.


Please be aware that the St. Labre Indian School is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (drinking water regulations), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the drinking water regulations may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties.

Each year, EPA sends a sampling schedule to the school, which outlines specific drinking water monitoring requirements. Please pay close attention to the sampling schedule, and ensure that samples are collected on time and reported to EPA on time to avoid violations.
