## Dear Chairman Davis:

This is an Addendum to the Administrative Order (Order) issued to the Blackfeet Tribe of the Blackfeet Reservation of Montana (Tribe) on January 15, 2021. The purpose of this letter is to approve the Tribe's June 7, 2021 schedule (Schedule) to correct significant deficiencies identified in the August 14, 2017 Sanitary Survey report regarding culverts near Wells WL01 and WL02 and potential contamination of the wells. The Schedule is hereby incorporated into the Order pursuant to paragraph 19. Each milestone and deadline specified below is an enforceable provision of the Order.

<u>Milestone</u> <u>Deadline</u>

Propose design specifications for a new 12-inch culvert in the	June 15, 2021
intermittent stream near WL02 (north well) of approximately 190 linear	
feet, so as to create a 100-foot offset from WL02, by working either	
with contractors or IHS.	
Procure contractor for installation of 12-inch culvert in accordance with	August 2, 2021
design specifications.	
Obtain a 404-permit from the Army Corps of Engineers for the	August 2, 2021
installation of the new culvert, if needed.	
Complete installation of 12-inch culvert in accordance with design	September 17, 2021
specifications.	

Abandon WL01 in accordance with MDEQ ARM well abandonment	November 1, 2021
procedures.	
Make observations of culvert effectiveness and submit report to EPA	June 1, 2022
regarding whether or not additional steps are needed to ensure no	
standing water is within 100 feet of WL02.	
If necessary, repeat above steps with additional engineering solutions to	November 1, 2022
address problem during summer of 2022.	

Within 10 calendar days of completing all steps included in the above Schedule, please notify the EPA of the project's completion as required by the Order. The Order also requires the Tribe to correct the significant deficiency by the final date specified in the approved Schedule. The EPA is authorized to seek penalties if these deadlines are not met. If the Tribe has a reasonable basis to believe it may be unable to meet any deadline in the Schedule, it must notify the EPA well in advance of the Scheduled deadline to request an extension. The EPA may, in its discretion, consider granting an extension. For any deadline prior to the date the Addendum was issued, please notify the EPA within 14 days when the milestone was completed or if the deadline was not met, provide a new proposed deadline.

As a reminder, you are required to notify the public of violations quarterly until they are corrected. If not already accomplished, please provide the EPA with a copy of the most recent public notice that was due by July 10, 2021, and the certification that the Tribe delivered it.

In addition, the EPA acknowledges that the COVID-19 pandemic also may impact construction projects.
