
Agreed Motion to Extend Alternative Dispute Resolution Period

1. The United States Environmental Protection Agency (“U.S. EPA”) filed a complaint in this matter on March 26, 2009.
2. Complainant and Respondent mutually agreed to attempt to resolve the issues presented in the complaint by means of the alternative dispute resolution (“ADR”) procedures offered by the Court pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 22.18(d).
3. On June 24, 2009, Complainant and Respondent reached a settlement in principle of all issues.
4. The initial period established for ADR in this matter will expire on July 6, 2009.
5. Counsel for Complainant intends to promptly draft the Consent Agreement/Final Order (“CAFO”) for this matter.
6. Accordingly, the parties jointly request an extension of the ADR period for another thirty days, *i.e.* until August 6, 2009, in which to submit to the Court a CAFO resolving all issues in this case.


