
Dear Mayor Vavricek:

On June 18, 2012, the referenced Administrative Order for Compliance was issued by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to the City of Grand Island under the authority of Section 309(a) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1319(a). The EPA has reviewed the information submitted by you in response to the required compliance activities outlined in the Order and has determined that those requirements have been adequately met. This letter serves as a notification to you that the EPA is terminating the Order. The EPA's decision to terminate the Order is conditioned upon the accuracy of your representations to the EPA in response to the requirements of the Order. You are reminded that the biosolids report is required to be submitted to the EPA no later than February 19 of each year.

Termination of this Order in no way relieves you of the obligation to comply with your National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit and all applicable statutes and regulations. The effect of this termination is limited to the requirements imposed under the Order. The EPA reserves all of its authorities, both legal and equitable, under the CWA and any other statutory, regulatory, or common law authorities of the United States.
