This is an Addendum to the Administrative Order (Order) issued on August 14, 2025, to the Cut Bank North Glacier County Water and Sewer District (District). The purpose of this letter is to approve the District's August 26, 2025 schedule (Schedule) for coming into consistent compliance with the requirements of the Lead and Copper Rule Improvements of 40 C.F.R. part 141 (Part 141), specifically 40 C.F.R. §§ 141.84, 141.85, and 141.90. The Schedule is hereby incorporated into the Order pursuant to paragraph 19. Each milestone and deadline specified below is an enforceable provision of the Order.

Provide Tier 2 Public Notice for failure to	
develop and submit a lead service line	Completed
inventory (LSLI) by the required deadline.	
Provide a copy of the enclosed LSLI	
template to the System's water users for	Completed
data entry on customer-owned service line	
material.	
Provide Tier 3 Public Notice for failure to	Completed
submit a LSLI to the Montana Department	
of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) by the	
compliance deadline.	

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Submit the LSLI to the EPA and MDEQ.	February 14, 2026
Make the LSLI publicly available and notify and provide required public education materials to all customers served by a lead service line, galvanized pipe(s) requiring replacement, or a lead status unknown sercvice line.	March 16, 2026
Provide EPA and MDEQ with a copy of the public education provided to consumers.	March 26, 2026

Within 10 calendar days of completing all steps included in the above Schedule, please notify the EPA of the project's completion as required by the Order. The Order also requires the District to achieve and maintain compliance with 40 C.F.R. § 141.84, 141.85, and 141.90 by the final date specified in the approved Schedule. If the District has a reasonable basis to believe it may be unable to meet any deadline in the Schedule, it must notify the EPA well in advance of the Scheduled deadline to request an extension. The EPA may, in its discretion, consider granting an extension.
