This letter serves as a Status Report, which was ordered on March 22, 2010, by Michael C. Barra, Regional Judicial Officer, of the Environmental Protection Agency.

Per my telephone conversation with Bryant Smalley of the EPA Superfund Division this morning, I discovered that my husband, John Mulkey, had a conversation with Mr. Smalley sometime in February, 2010. During that conversation, Mr. Smalley evidently told my husband that one additional piece of information was needed before the above referenced issue could be settled. Unfortunately, my husband was severely ill in February and may very well have not even remembered talking with Mr. Smalley. I suggest that because he never mentioned the conversation to me.
