Dear Mr. Davis,

This letter is to inform you of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) decision to close the Administrative Order on Consent (Order) for the Town of Fowler, Colorado, Docket No. CWA-08-2022-0003, dated March 24, 2022. The EPA has determined that the Town of Fowler has no remaining obligations under the Order and, therefore, is closing the Order at this time.

Please be aware that the Town of Fowler is still required to comply with the Clean Water Act (Act) and its implementing pretreatment regulations, including section 307 of the Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1317, and 40 C.F.R. part 403. Violations of the Act or its implementing pretreatment regulations may result in a courtimposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$68,445 per day for each violation.
