This letter is to inform you and Harmony Farms Water Users Association, of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Administrative Order (Order), Docket No. SDWA-08-2009-0078, issued to the Harmony Farms Water Users Association public water system on October 26, 2009. EPA has determined that Harmony Farms Water Users Association is now in compliance with the requirements of the Administrative Order and therefore we will close the Order at this time.

Please be aware that Harmony Farms Users Association is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (NPDWRs), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs may result in a court-imposed injunction and/or penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
