This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Emergency Administrative Order (Emergency Order), issued on July 18, 2008 to the Flying X Ranch Mobile Home Park (Flying X). EPA has determined that Flying X has completed all actions outlined in EPA's July 18, 2008 Emergency Order and that the water provided by the Flying X water system no longer presents an imminent and substantial endangerment to public health. Therefore EPA will close the Emergency Order at this time. However, EPA remains concerned that samples taken at the Flying X water system tested positive for fecal coliform on November 10, 2008, and tested positive for total coliform on November 10 and 18, 2008. Although the System was closed at the time, EPA recommends that you maintain operation of the disinfection equipment during all periods when the water may be consumed.

Please be aware that the Flying X Ranch Mobile Home Park is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (NPDWR), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs may result in a court-imposed injunction and penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
