Dear Mayor Shain:

This letter is to inform you of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) decision to close the Emergency Administrative Order (Emergency Order), issued on October 27, 2010 to the Town of Pine Bluffs. EPA has determined that the Town of Pine Bluffs has completed all actions outlined in EPA's October 27, 2010 Emergency Order and that the water provided by the Town of Pine Bluffs water system no longer presents an imminent and substantial endangerment to public health. Therefore EPA will close the Emergency Order at this time.

Please be aware that the Town of Pine Bluffs is still required to comply with the National Primary Drinking Water Regulations (NPDWR), 40 C.F.R. part 141. Violation of the NPDWRs may result in a court-imposed injunction and penalties of up to \$37,500 per day of violation.
